



Steps to Host a FAFSA Completion Event

1. Schedule a time (Oct-Dec) when parents & students can meet together for an FAFSA completion event (it might need to be held outside of school hours). Some communities might also choose to do a 2nd FAFSA event Jan-Feb
2. Contact financial aid representative from a local community college, technical college, or university to help present information and answer questions for parents during the event.
