The Institution Retention Rate includes a cohort of first-time, full-time, degree-seeking students who enrolled at the same institution for two consecutive Fall terms. The System Retention Rate for each institution includes a cohort of first-time, full-time, degree-seeking students who enrolled the first Fall term at the institution indicated but enrolled in the second Fall term at any public higher education institution. The overall System Retention Rate includes a cohort of first-time, full-time, degree-seeking students who enrolled in two consecutive Fall terms in any public higher education
