BOARD CHAIRMAN PRAISES SENATE'S DEFERRED MAINTENANCE PLAN

(TOPEKA) – This afternoon Regent Nelson Galle, Chairman of the Kansas Board of Regents, issued the following statement regarding the Senate Ways and Means Committee's approval of a comprehensive higher education maintenance funding plan:
