## **ENROLLMENT SURVEY INDICATES STATE UNIVERSITY ISSUES IMPACT ALL STATE LEGISLATORS**

### *Survey Displays Importance of Addressing Issues Such As Deferred Building Maintenance*

(TOPEKA) – Today the Kansas Board of Regents released an enrollment survey that displays state university student enrollment by county and approximate state legislative districts. The information indicates that all 165 state legislators have a significant number of constituents in the counties they represent who attend a state university.

“There’s often an assumption that state university issues are of less importance to legislative districts that do not have a university located in that particular place,” said Reginald L. Robinson, President and CEO of the Kansas Board of Regents. “However, this enrollment survey clearly illustrates that all 165 state legislators have a significant number of constituents who are enrolled in and families whose children attend our state’s universities. That means issues such as state university funding and deferred building maintenance are vital for each legislator to address in order to adequately represent the interests of his or her constituents.”

In the State House of Representatives, Representative Anthony Brown (R-Eudora) had the greatest number of constituents (16,114 students) attending a state university. In the State Senate, Senator Nick Jordan (R-Shawnee) had the greatest number of constituents (13,691 students) attending a state university.
