## BOARD OF REGENTS ANNOUNCES 2007 SPRING ENROLLMENT

### *State University Enrollment Increases by 166 Students*

(TOPEKA) – Enrollment figures released today by the Kansas Board of Regents show an increase of 166 students at the six state universities. This represents a 0.2% increase for the 2007 spring semester over the 2006 spring semester. The state's six universities reported a combined enrollment of 82,788 students as of the 20<sup>th</sup> day of classes.

“Increased student enrollment is yet another important example of why the issue of state university deferred building maintenance must be addressed this legislative session,” said Reginald L. Robinson, President and CEO of the Kansas Board of Regents. “Our state universities continue to experience increased enrollments while campus facilities frequently do not meet student needs. Students are preparing for an increasingly challenging and competitive job market in buildings that are vastly out-dated and in a state of disrepair.”
