### KANSAS BOARD OF REGENTS Math Faculty Professional Development MINUTES January 24<sup>th</sup>, 2025

The January 24<sup>th</sup>, 2025, Math Faculty Professional Development session was called to order by Whitney Turner at 2:00 p.m. The meeting was held via zoom.

### Welcome

Whitney Turner called the meeting to order and introduced herself as the co-chair of the Math Pathways Task Force. She shared that this meeting will be the last in the Math Pathways Professional Development series.

### Assessing Math Pathways Programs

Brandon Protas from Complete College America introduced himself and began the presentation by explaining the difference between the Traditional Prerequisite Remedial Model and the Corequisite Support Model. He shared data exhibiting the success of prerequisite developmental education as compared to corequisite support. He emphasized that the Corequisite Model increases student success as well as saving students time and money. He covered types of assessment, including using outcomes data and direct student feedback, and how using both can help improve programs. Brandon was asked if he thought data would change significantly when looking at a cohort of non-traditional students who have been out of school for a number of years. He responded that research has found that students of all levels of academic preparedness had better outcomes with the corequisite model. He added that the results have been consistent across the board between two-year and four-year institutions.

Dr. JBR was asked if KBOR will be using the through-put rate instead of course pass rate in its assessment of the programs. She responded that the CCA launch event in February will have a session to discuss how both KBOR and institutions will measure effectiveness.

Concerns were raised regarding students who are not prepared for the corequisite courses. Brandon Protas responded that research shows that all students are better supported through corequisite compared to prerequisite support.

# Asset-Based Perspectives
