






Campus Bookshelves - Instructor-curated and syllabus-based textbooks organized by Institution.

Bookshelves - Traditional "stand-alone" textbooks organized by discipline or subdiscipline.







Published vs. Unpublished



Both are accessible and editable by the authoring team.

Only Published books have all of the features (printing, PDF, etc).

Only Published books will be on the Commons, Campus Commons, and discoverable by the public, including search.

Unpublished books are only available to the authoring team.




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




Getting Started: Books in the Commons






Getting Started: Book Features in the Commons




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

Mechanisms for Authoring & Incorporation

Development of content in the LibreTexts platform proceeds via five mechanisms operating in parallel:

- Mechanism 1: Student contribution from scratch (e.g., via extra credit)
- Mechanism 2: Student integration of existing content outside the LibreTexts platform from faculty and experts
- Mechanism 3: Faculty construction of raw content from scratch
- Mechanism 4: Faculty integration of existing content outside the LibreTexts platform from faculty and experts
- Mechanism 5: Faculty and student re-editing of content already existing on the LibreTexts (with permission)

From Word

Mechanism I

- · Pull PDF into Google doc (first upload pdf to Google Drive, then select "Open in Google Doc")
- Follow Google Doc workflow

Mechanism II

- · Build the empty Text Skeleton

- Clear formatting as needed since word generates messy code)
- Edit and typeset pages as needed
- . Use Mathpix for OCRing equations as needed User GrindEO to convert MS equations to latex

Mechanism I · Convert to EPUB file

- User LT Importer to import EPUB file (admin use only)
- · Edit and typeset pages as needed

Mechanism II Build the empty Text Skeleton

- . Copy & Paste content into each page individually
- · Edit and typeset pages as needed
- . Use Mathpix for OCRing equations as needed

From EPUB/Common Cartridge

- · User LT Importer to import EPUB file
- · Edit and typeset pages as needed

If the EPUB is unvalidated (poorly constructed), then the LT importer will not generate all pages and will push chapter content into single pages. If this happened, then user Remixer (in remix mode) to flesh out the text generated from the Importer (e.g. add relevant pages).

From Pressbooks

Mechanism I (if EPUB export option is available)

- · Export text into EPUB
- User LT Importer to import EPUB file (admin use only)
- · Edit and typeset pages as needed

From Lumen (modified Pressbooks)

Lumen platform is really a Pressbooks platform slightly modified with no export options (OER content is fettered).

- . Import into LT Pressbooks instance (admin use only)
- · Export text into EPUB
- User LT Importer to import EPUB file (admin use only)
- · Edit and typeset pages as needed

Requires admin access to the importer to harvest.






Numbers which make the boxplot might be returned with fivenum() command. Boxplot representation was created by a famous American mathematician John W. Tukey as a quick, powerful and consistent way of reflecting main distribution-independent characteristics of the sample. In R, boxplot() is vectorized so we can draw several boxplots at once (Figure 4.2.3):

Code 4.2.2 (R): Boxplots | boxplot(scale(trees)) | | run | restart | restart & run all |

(Parameters of trees were measured in different units, therefore we scale()'d them.)

Histogram is another graphical representation of the sample where range is divided into intervals (bins), and consecutive bars are drawn with their height proportional to the count of values in each bin (Figure 4.2.4):

Code 4.2.3 (R): Histograms hist(salary2, breaks=20) run restart restart & run all

(By default, the command hist() would have divided the range into 10 bins, but here we needed 20 and therefore set them manually. Histogram is sometimes a rather cryptic way to display the data. Commands Histp() and Histr() from the asmisc.r will plot histograms together with percentages on the top of each bar, or overlaid with normal curve (or density—see below), respectively. Please try them yourself.)

A numerical analog of a histogram is the function cut():

There are other graphical functions, conceptually similar to histograms. The first is stem-and-leaf plot. stem() is a kind of pseudograph, text histogram. Let us see how it treats the original vector salary:
