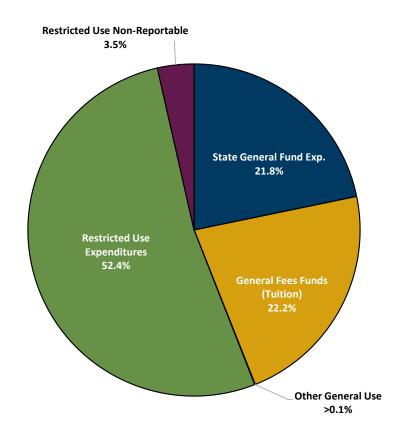

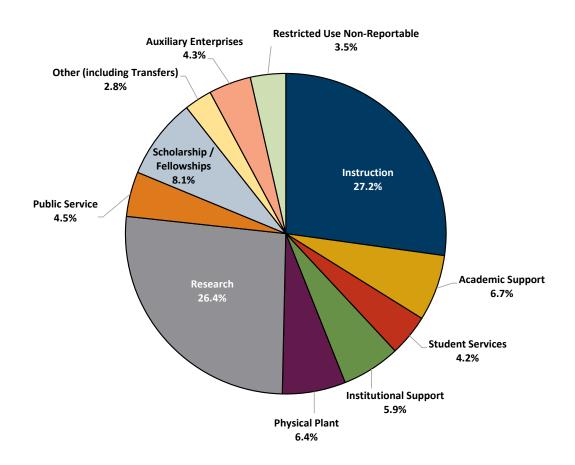

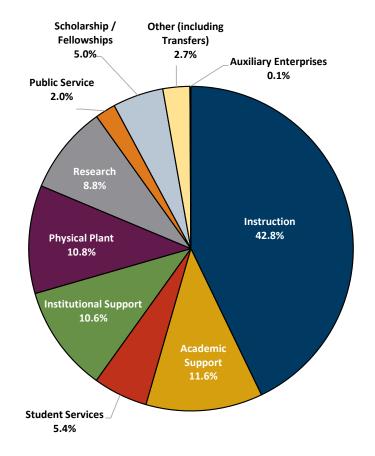

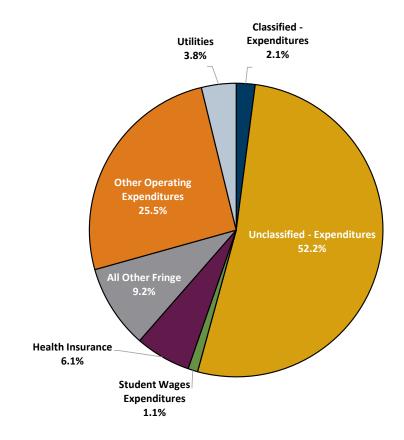

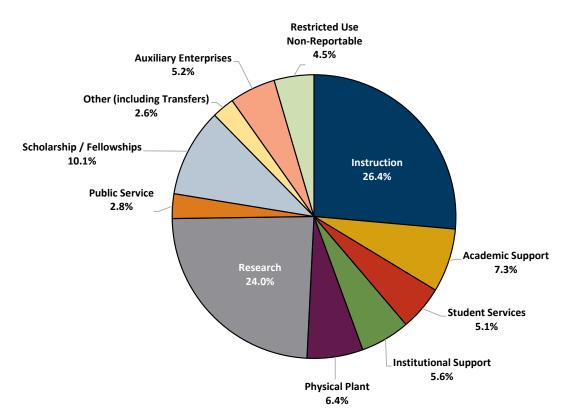

### Table 1.40: Gross General Use Educational Expenditures per Student Credit Hour and per Fall FTE Student

- 1. The Educational Program consists of expenditures for Instruction, Academic Support, Student Services and Institutional Support. This comparison allows analysis of change in those expenditures on a per student basis. Change in expenditures per student may result from either budgetary adjustments or enrollment change. This comparison makes no distinction on variance by educational level of academic discipline.
- 2. Prior to Fall 2018, the full-time equivalent (FTE) was calculated from credit hours enrolled on 20<sup>th</sup> class day at the rate of:
  - 1 FTE for each 15 credit hours of undergraduate enrollment

Starting Fall 2018, the full-time equivalent (FTE) is calculated from credit hours enrolled on 20th class day at the rate of:

- 1 FTE for each 15 credit hours of undergraduate enrollment
- 1 FTE for each 12 credit hours of graduate enrollment, regardless of student level or program

This change was made to better align with other KBOR collections, IPEDS, and SHEF. All FTE data in this table has been modified using the updated calculations and may not match the per Fall FTE student data in previously published data books.
