# Criminal Justice Report Writing Course Information

#### Credit Hours 3

Students are required to gather pertinent information and then record that information by writing a variety of report narratives representative to those prepared by individuals working in a profession within the criminal justice system. Students will also become familiar with, and complete, a full casefile, including all pertinent forms and sketches.
